Thank you for interest in considering to become an Environmental Review Team (CT ERT) Team Member. CTRC&D's CTERT has been in existence for over 45 years in Connecticut providing valuable non-regulatory information to all municipalities free of charge in the advancement of making wise land use decisions.

In 2013 our program because of funding has had to re-focus our efforts and the services we provide to Connecticut municipalities and land trusts organizations and provide a valuable and usable technical service needed by municipalities in Connecticut. We work to offer these services for a very low cost or free to the municipalities and land trusts.

Volunteers

Our program can offer this technical service to all municipalities for a low cost through your volunteer time. We can provide a \$100.00 stipend per review for those able to accept it. In order to be eligible to receive this stipend you must participate in the field review the day of the ERT and submit your report by the deadline that is given. Once both are satisfied you will be able to submit a payment request form which will be processed and payment mailed to you within 15 business days.

We are looking for team members with expertise in the areas of soils, wetland delineation, wildlife, architecture, archaeology, watershed management, ecology, forestry, geology, greenways, invasive plants, planning, recreation, transportation, wetlands, wildlife, herpetology and agriculture.

On-Call Consulting

We also have a database of natural resource experts who provide ERT reviews at a lower cost. This provides the municipality or land trust the option of specialized evaluation of a particular resource. If you or your company would like to help the ERT program in this regard, please contact the CTRC&D office.
